

# Introductory Activity: Rapid Fire



## Summary

Rapid fire is a very quick, versatile ice breaker that can be shortened or extended to suit the time limits of your meeting. Participants give 1-word answers to questions as fast as they can.

## Details

**Time:** 2 - 6 minutes

**Best for session #:** Any

## Instructions

1. Come up with some questions that you can answer with one or two words.
2. If you are not already seated in a U-shape, get the students to stand in a circle. (Or any formation with a clear path connecting each student.)
3. Ask the question, and get the kids to answer quickly to see how fast you can get around the room.
4. Ask any number of questions.

## Sample Questions

- What is your name?
- What school do you go to?
- What grade are you in?
- What is your favorite color?
- How many siblings do you have?
- What is one word that describes you?
- What did you eat for breakfast?
- What do you want to be when you're older?
- What is one of your hobbies?
- What is your favorite meeting role?
- What is your favorite subject?

- \*How many times have you [...]
- \*How old were you when [...]
